#### **Embedding children and young people's participation in health and social care**

**Louca-Mai Brady** is currently using action research to explore participation in health and social care service, as part of her doctoral research. In this seminar she will explore what it means to 'embed' children and young people's participation in health and social care services and discuss some of the issues emerging from her research and a number of related workshops. Attendees will also have an opportunity to contribute to this on-going work by reflecting on their own knowledge and experience of children and young people's participation in health and social care

**Louca-Mai Brady** roles have included Senior researcher at the National Children's Bureau Research Centre, where she led the Centre's work on the involvement in children and young people in research. She is also a member of INVOLVE and is currently supporting the involvement of young people with experience of using drug and alcohol services in an NIHR Health Technology Assessment programme study.

#### **Using youth led research to create change in the NHS**

This seminar will explore the possibilities and limits offered by research led by young people as a method of creating changes in NHS Services. Drawing on the learning from a number of pieces of youth led research in the health sector, Dan will present the impact of these pieces of the work on policy design and service delivery, and the challenges faced when using young people's voices as the starting point for service design.

**Dan** has worked on participation and youth led research programmes on behalf of Cheshire and Merseyside Public Health Network, The Child Health Development Programme DoH, NHS-NW, The North West Regional Youth Work Unit, Tobacco Free Futures and many others. Dan is currently the Director of People Dialogue and Change, and an Associate Director at the University of Central Lancashire's Centre for Children and Young People's Participation.
